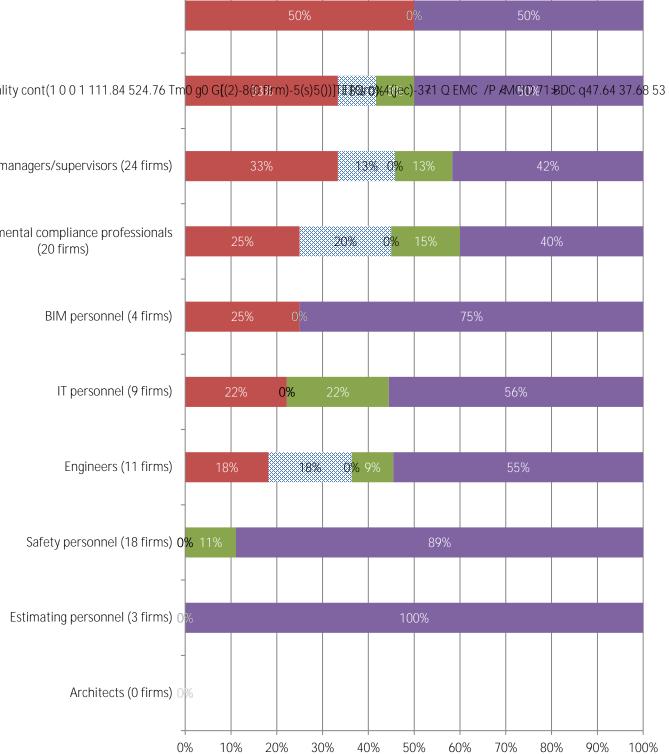

5. Do you expect any changes in the availability of hourly craft or salaried personnel over the coming 12 months?

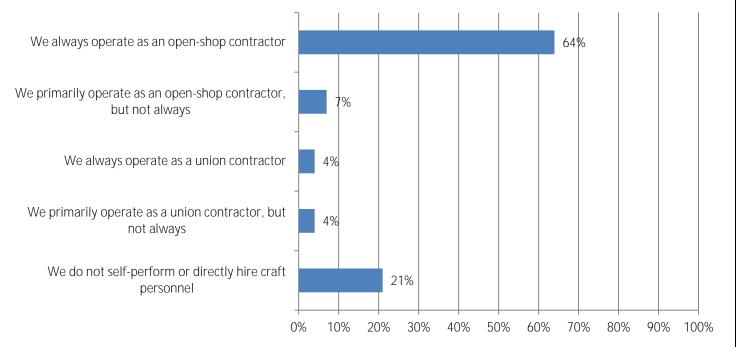

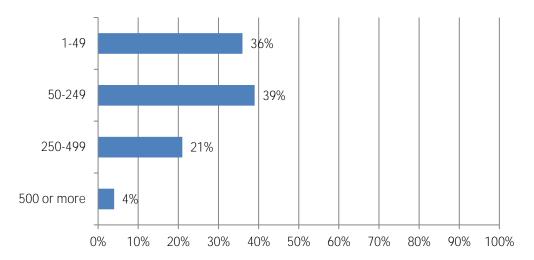
